AN ACT

Amending the act of May 28, 1937 (P.L.955, No.265), entitled, as amended, "An act to promote public health, safety, morals, 2 and welfare by declaring the necessity of creating public 3 bodies, corporate and politic, to be known as housing 4 authorities to engage in slum clearance, and to undertake 5 projects, to provide dwelling accommodations for persons of 6 low income; providing for the organization of such housing 7 authorities; defining their powers and duties; providing for 8 9 the exercise of such powers, including the acquisition of property by purchase, gift or eminent domain, the renting and 10 selling of property, and including borrowing money, issuing 11 bonds, and other obligations, and giving security therefor; 12 prescribing the remedies of obligees of housing authorities; 13 14 authorizing housing authorities to enter into agreements, including agreements with the United States, the 15 Commonwealth, and political subdivisions and municipalities 16 17 thereof; defining the application of zoning, sanitary, and building laws and regulations to projects built or maintained 18 by such housing authorities; exempting the property and securities of such housing authorities from taxation; and 19 20 imposing duties and conferring powers upon the State Planning 21 Board, and certain other State officers and departments," 22 further providing for powers of an authority. 23

- 24 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 25 hereby enacts as follows:
- 26 Section 1. Section 10(ee) of the act of May 28, 1937
- 27 (P.L.955, No.265), known as the Housing Authorities Law, added
- 28 October 4, 1978 (P.L.1008, No.215), is amended to read:

- 1 Section 10. Powers of an Authority. -- An Authority shall
- 2 constitute a public body, corporate and politic, exercising
- 3 public powers of the Commonwealth as an agency thereof, which
- 4 powers shall include all powers necessary or appropriate to
- 5 carry out and effectuate the purpose and provisions of this act,
- 6 including the following powers, in addition to others herein
- 7 granted:
- 8 * * *
- 9 (ee) In a county of the second class and city of the second
- 10 class, to appoint police officers who shall [have the same
- 11 rights, powers and duties as other peace officers in the
- 12 Commonwealth] <u>exercise the same powers that may be exercised</u>
- 13 under authority of law or ordinance by the police of the
- 14 municipalities wherein the Authority is located, including, but
- 15 not limited to, those powers conferred pursuant to 42 Pa.C.S.
- 16 Ch. 89 Subch. D (relating to municipal police jurisdiction) with
- 17 respect to the property and enforcing order on and adjacent to
- 18 the grounds and buildings of the Authority: Provided, That said
- 19 police officers complete the same course of instruction as is
- 20 required for municipal police officers by [the act of June 18,
- 21 1974 (P.L.359, No.120), referred to as the Municipal Police
- 22 Education and Training Law] <u>53 Pa.C.S. Ch. 21 Subch. D (relating</u>
- 23 to municipal police education and training), and receive
- 24 certification by the Municipal Police Officers' Education and
- 25 Training Commission as having completed the instruction. Said
- 26 police officers shall maintain the certification as a condition
- 27 of employment as police officers for the Authority.
- 28 * * *
- 29 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
