Section 5551(5) of Title 42 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: 7 8 § 5551. No limitation applicable. 9 A prosecution for the following offenses may be commenced at 10 any time: 11 12 (5) A violation of [75 Pa.C.S. § 3742 (relating to 13 accidents involving death or personal injury) or 3732 14 (relating to homicide by vehicle)] any of the following if 15 the accused was the driver of a vehicle involved in an 16 accident resulting in the death of any person[.]:
