## AN ACT

- 1 Designating a bridge on that portion of S.R. 4002, Clarence
- Road, in Snow Shoe Township, Centre County, as the Clarence
- 3 Bridge of Freedom for All Veterans.
- 4 The General Assembly finds that:
- 5 (1) Snow Shoe Township, Centre County, has had many veterans
- 6 who have served and died for our country.
- 7 (2) Many of them have passed through the bridge on that
- 8 portion of S.R. 4002, Clarence Road, in the township.
- 9 (3) All of these veterans have given some service and some
- 10 of them have given all in service to their country.
- 11 (4) The bridge should be named for all of these veterans who
- 12 have served their country well.
- 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 14 hereby enacts as follows:
- 15 Section 1. Clarence Bridge of Freedom for All Veterans.
- 16 (a) Designation. -- The bridge located on S.R. 4002, Clarence

- 1 Road, in Snow Shoe Township, Centre County, is hereby designated
- 2 the Clarence Bridge of Freedom for All Veterans.
- 3 (b) Signs.—The Department of Transportation shall erect and
- 4 maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the bridge to
- 5 traffic in both directions on the bridge.
- 6 Section 2. Effective date.
- 7 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
