AN ACT

Amending Title 4 (Amusements) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 1 Statutes, further providing for investigations and 2 enforcement. 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Section 1517(a.1)(2) of Title 4 of the 6 7 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read: 8 § 1517. Investigations and enforcement. * * * 9 10 (a.1) Powers and duties of bureau. -- The Bureau of 11 Investigations and Enforcement shall have the following powers 12 and duties: * * * 13 14 Investigate and review all applicants and 15 applications for a license, permit or registration. The 16 bureau shall be prohibited from disclosing any portion of a background investigation report to any member prior to the 17

- 1 submission of the bureau's final background investigation
- 2 report relating to the applicant's suitability for licensure
- 3 to the board. The Office of Enforcement Counsel, on behalf of
- 4 the bureau, shall prepare the final background investigation
- 5 report for inclusion in a final report relating to the
- 6 applicant's suitability for licensure. Appended to each such
- 7 report shall be all information collected by the bureau that
- 8 <u>relates to the applicant.</u>

- 10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
