## AN ACT

1 2	Prohibiting certain road signs from displaying the name of the sitting Governor.
3	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4	hereby enacts as follows:
5	Section 1. Prohibition.
6	The name of the sitting Governor of the Commonwealth may not
7	be displayed on any road sign erected, purchased or maintained
8	by the Department of Transportation, the Pennsylvania Turnpike
9	Commission or any other State agency, bureau or commission if
10	the road sign is located at or near the border of this
11	Commonwealth and another state and the road sign primarily
12	serves to welcome motorists to this Commonwealth or to inform
13	persons that they are entering this Commonwealth.
14	Section 2. Effective date.
15	This act shall take effect immediately.
