AN ACT

- 1 Making an appropriation to the Department of Education to
- 2 promote activities and services to increase the preparation,
- enrollment and success of low-income students in
- 4 postsecondary education.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Legislative intent.
- 8 The General Assembly finds and declares as follows:
- 9 (1) It is the intent of the General Assembly to continue
- 10 to promote activities and services to increase the
- 11 preparation, enrollment and success of low-income students in
- 12 postsecondary education.
- 13 (2) This act provides funding to continue activities in
- 14 this Commonwealth previously carried out under the federally
- funded College Access Challenge Grant Program by supporting
- these activities and services with State funds.
- 17 Section 2. Appropriation.
- The sum of \$7,034,000, or as much hereof as may be necessary,

- 1 is hereby appropriated to the Department of Education for the
- 2 fiscal year July 1, 2012, to June 30, 2013, to promote
- 3 activities and services to increase the preparation, enrollment
- 4 and success of low-income students in postsecondary education.
- 5 Section 3. Effective date.
- 6 This act shall take effect immediately.
