## A RESOLUTION

Designating the week of June 18 through 24, 2012, as "Pollinator 1 Week" in Pennsylvania. 2 3 WHEREAS, Pollinator species such as birds and insects, 4 including bees, are essential partners of farmers and ranchers 5 in producing much of our food supply; and 6 WHEREAS, Pollination plays a vital role in the health of our 7 national forests and grasslands, which provide forage, fish and wildlife, timber, water, mineral resources and recreational 8 9 opportunities, as well as enhanced economic development 10 opportunities for communities; and 11 WHEREAS, Pollinator species, such as bees, provide 12 significant environmental benefits that are necessary for maintaining healthy, biodiverse ecosystems; and 13 14 WHEREAS, The Commonwealth has managed wildlife habitats and 15 public lands such as forests and grasslands for decades; and 16 WHEREAS, The Bee Law, which appears in Chapter 21 of Title 3 17 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, and other laws and 18 regulatory means provide producers with conservation assistance

to promote wise conservation stewardship, including the protection and maintenance of pollinators and their habitats on working lands and wildlands and, through the Department of Agriculture, register and regulate each apiary; therefore be it RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the week of June 18 through 24, 2012, as "Pollinator Week" in Pennsylvania.
