## A RESOLUTION

Recognizing the 225 th anniversary of the signing of the Constitution of the United States.

WHEREAS, On September $17,1787,42$ of the 55 delegates to the Constitutional Convention held their final meeting, with only one item of business occupying the agenda that day, to sign the Constitution of the United States; and

WHEREAS, After being signed in September of 1787 , Congress sent printed copies of the Constitution of the United States to the state legislatures for ratification; and

WHEREAS, By June 21, 1788, nine states had approved the Constitution of the United States, finally forming "a more perfect Union"; and
