## A RESOLUTION

- Designating the week of April 15 through 21, 2012, as "Local Government Week" and April 17, 2012, as "Local Government
- 3 Day" in Pennsylvania.
- 4 WHEREAS, The Commonwealth is served by an interconnected
- 5 system of 67 counties, 56 cities, 958 boroughs, 91 first class
- 6 townships, 1,454 second class townships, one town, 500 school
- 7 districts and more than 1,500 active municipal authorities; and
- 8 WHEREAS, More than 12 million Pennsylvania residents rely on
- 9 the services and facilities provided by local government,
- 10 ranging from the special purpose functions of counties, school
- 11 districts and municipal authorities in the areas of judicial
- 12 administration, social welfare, education and provision of water
- 13 and sewer services to the more general purpose functions of
- 14 cities, boroughs, towns and townships, such as maintenance of

- 1 roads and streets, police and fire protection and enforcement of
- 2 ordinances and land use controls; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Local government comprises thousands of hardworking
- 4 citizen officials, many of whom serve without reward, who hold
- 5 these local government offices; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Local government also comprises thousands of
- 7 dedicated staff members who carry out the directives of the
- 8 local elected officials and who are supplemented by thousands of
- 9 tireless volunteers who serve on various local boards and
- 10 commissions; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Pennsylvania's residents rely upon the dedication of
- 12 these local officials in meeting many of the residents' most
- 13 fundamental needs in nearly all facets of daily living; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Local government is the backbone of our democracy
- 15 and the bedrock of our political system; and
- 16 WHEREAS, The success of our local officials is a key element
- 17 in the overall quality of life in this Commonwealth; and
- 18 WHEREAS, It is only fitting that each year in Pennsylvania
- 19 one week is set aside as "Local Government Week" and one day as
- 20 "Local Government Day"; and
- 21 WHEREAS, "Local Government Week" and "Local Government Day"
- 22 focus attention on the need for strong, independent and active
- 23 local government in this Commonwealth and recognize the valuable
- 24 contributions made by residents serving their communities;
- 25 therefore be it
- 26 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 27 week of April 15 through 21, 2012, as "Local Government Week"
- 28 and April 17, 2011, as "Local Government Day" in Pennsylvania;
- 29 and be it further
- 30 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives commend and thank

- 1 the Commonwealth's local officials for their labor as the unsung
- 2 heroes of government.
