## A RESOLUTION

Recognizing the Pennsylvania Junior Wrestling organization on the occasion of the 50th anniversary of its founding.

WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Junior Wrestling organization is
one of the most longstanding and successful youth wrestling
programs in the United States; and
WHEREAS, The founder of Pennsylvania Junior Wrestling was John Harwick of Clymer, who became a teacher and coach of Oswayo Valley and Marion Center High Schools and subsequently a college professor; and

WHEREAS, The first Junior Olympic tournament held at Waynesburg in 1963 attracted 200 wrestlers; and

WHEREAS, The program continued to expand to eight area tournaments, and in 1971, 7,400 wrestlers participated in the tournaments; and

WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Junior Wrestling organization has continued to expand; and

WHEREAS, During the past 50 years, it is estimated that more than 286,000 youth participated in the Pennsylvania Junior Wrestling program; therefore be it RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the Pennsylvania Junior Wrestling organization on the occasion of its 50th anniversary of its founding; and be it further RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives extend its best wishes for the organization's continued success in the future.
