## A RESOLUTION

1 2	Honoring Bally, Berks County, Pennsylvania, on the occasion of the 100th anniversary of its founding.
3	WHEREAS, The Borough of Bally was originally called
4	Goshenhoppen, an Indian word meaning "meeting place"; and
5	WHEREAS, Mennonites and Catholics settled the borough in the
6	area in the early 18th century; and
7	WHEREAS, Bally has traditionally been the home of many
8	Pennsylvania Dutch settlers and their descendants; and
9	WHEREAS, There are numerous businesses and industries in
10	Bally, some of which are known internationally; and
11	WHEREAS, Among the largest industries are Bally Ribbon Mills,
12	Bally Block Co. and Peerless Boilers; and
13	WHEREAS, Two other major manufacturers, Great American
14	Knitting Mills (now Gold Toe Socks) and Bally Case and Cooler
15	(now Bally Refrigerated Boxes) were founded in Bally and were

1 located there for decades; and

2 WHEREAS, The Bally area is also well known for its 3 agriculture; and

WHEREAS, Bally lies in the heart of an area named "Butter
Valley," extending from Hereford, through Bally, to Boyertown;
and

7 WHEREAS, The name is due to the large number of dairy farms
8 in the valley; and

9 WHEREAS, Renowned Italian artist, furniture designer and metal sculpture musician Harry Bertoia settled in the area and 10 established his Bertoia Studio on Main Street in Bally; and 11 WHEREAS, The Borough of Bally is celebrating the 100th 12 13 anniversary of its founding this year; therefore be it 14 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives honor the Borough of Bally on the occasion of the 100th anniversary of its 15 16 founding.
