AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in vocational education, further 5 providing for the definition of "vocational agricultural 6 education." 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. Section 1801(4) of the act of March 10, 1949 11 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is 12 amended to read: 13 Section 1801. Definitions .-- The following words and phrases as used in this article shall, unless a different meaning is 14 15 plainly required by the context, have the following meanings: * * * 16 17 (4) "Vocational agricultural education" shall mean that form of vocational education which [fits for the occupations 18 19 connected with the tillage of the soil, the care of domestic

animals, forestry, and other wage-earning or productive work on

- 1 the farm] develops student potential for success in entering and
- 2 <u>advancing through careers in the food, agriculture and natural</u>
- 3 <u>resources sciences, such as production agriculture, animal</u>
- 4 <u>science</u>, <u>agribusiness management and marketing</u>, <u>agricultural</u>
- 5 <u>research, energy systems, agricultural mechanics and</u>
- 6 engineering, biotechnology, food science, processing and
- 7 retailing, banking, agricultural education, forestry,
- 8 horticulture, landscaping, leadership and career development,
- 9 <u>management</u>, economics and marketing, natural resource
- 10 management, plant and soil science, power and systems
- 11 technology, rural-urban interfacing and other related fields.
