## AN ACT

Amending the act of February 1, 1966 (1965 P.L.1656, No.581), entitled "An act concerning boroughs, and revising, amending and consolidating the law relating to boroughs," repealing provisions relating to right of council to declare seat of member vacant for failure to attend meetings.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Section 904 of the act of February 1, 1966 (1965 P.L.1656, No.581), known as The Borough Code, amended June 25, 2001 (P.L.651, No.56), is repealed:
[Section 904. Right of Council to Declare Seat of Member Vacant for Failure to Attend Meetings, Etc.--If any person, having qualified as a member of council, shall neglect or refuse to attend two successive regular meetings unless detained by sickness, or prevented by necessary absence from the borough, or if in attendance at any meetings shall neglect or refuse to vote or by withdrawal from council or otherwise refuse to act in the person's official capacity as a member of council, the borough council, acting without such person, may declare the person's
