## AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of April 16, 1992 (P.L.155, No.28), entitled
- 2 "An act providing for the certification and recertification
- of assessors; establishing eligibility and training
- 4 requirements; defining the powers and duties of the State
- 5 Board of Certified Real Estate Appraisers relating to
- training, certification and recertification of assessors; and
- authorizing the board to establish fees," further providing
- 8 for nonapplicability.
- 9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 10 hereby enacts as follows:
- 11 Section 1. Section 11 of the act of April 16, 1992 (P.L.155,
- 12 No.28), known as the Assessors Certification Act, amended
- 13 November 19, 2004 (P.L.834, No.100), is repealed:
- 14 [Section 11. Nonapplicability.
- 15 This act shall not apply to counties of the first class.]
- 16 Section 2. An assessor who is employed by a county of the
- 17 first class on the effective date of this section shall have
- 18 four years from the effective date of this section to become
- 19 certified under the act.
- 20 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
