AN ACT

1 Amending the act of April 16, 1992 (P.L.155, No.28), entitled
2 "An act providing for the certification and recertification
3 of assessors; establishing eligibility and training
4 requirements; defining the powers and duties of the State
5 Board of Certified Real Estate Appraisers relating to
6 training, certification and recertification of assessors; and
7 authorizing the board to establish fees," further providing
8 for nonapplicability.

9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
10 hereby enacts as follows:

11 Section 1. Section 11 of the act of April 16, 1992 (P.L.155,
12 No.28), known as the Assessors Certification Act, amended
13 November 19, 2004 (P.L.834, No.100), is repealed:

14 [Section 11. Nonapplicability.

15 This act shall not apply to counties of the first class.]

16 Section 2. An assessor who is employed by a county of the
17 first class on the effective date of this section shall have
18 four years from the effective date of this section to become
19 certified under the act.

20 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
