Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in registration of vehicles, further providing for 2 3 person with disability plate and placard. 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Section 1338 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read: 8 § 1338. Person with disability plate and placard. * * * 9 (a.1) Disability plate for wheelchair racks.--10 11 (1) A person with a disability who has been approved by 12 the department for a special registration plate under 13 subsection (a) and who intends to place such plate on a 14 passenger car or truck with a registered gross weight of not 15 more than 10,000 pounds that has affixed thereto a rack 16 designed to carry a wheelchair may request a second special 17 registration plate for display on the wheelchair rack. (2) Upon the payment of a fee equal to the amount of the 18

- 2 <u>shall issue a second special registration plate for display</u>
- 3 <u>exclusively on the wheelchair rack of the vehicle identified</u>
- 4 <u>in the application.</u>
- 5 (3) Once issued, the second special registration plate
- 6 <u>shall be attached to the wheelchair rack so long as the</u>
- 7 wheelchair rack is affixed to the vehicle. If the wheelchair
- 8 <u>rack is permanently removed from the vehicle, the second</u>
- 9 <u>special registration plate shall be returned to the</u>
- department in accordance with the provisions of section
- 11 1334(b) and (c) (relating to return of registration plate).

- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
