A RESOLUTION

1 Designating the month of June 2011 as "Men's Health Month" in
2 Pennsylvania.

3 WHEREAS, Men's Health Month is set aside to increase
4 awareness of preventable health conditions; and

5 WHEREAS, Men's Health Month further increases awareness of
6 the value of early detection and treatment for male-specific
7 diseases; and

8 WHEREAS, Health care providers, policymakers, media
9 representatives and many individuals in our communities
10 recognize the importance of seeking regular medical advice and
11 early treatment for disease or injury; and

12 WHEREAS, The Senate urges establishment and recognition of
13 men's health initiatives in our communities, participation in
14 events raising awareness of men's health issues and widespread
15 adoption of healthy lifestyles; therefore be it
