- 7 WHEREAS, Biomedical research has helped increase the life
- 8 span of people in the United States through the development of
- 9 vaccines, antibiotics and anti-infective drugs; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Biomedical research has contributed to the
- 11 elimination of many epidemic diseases, and in the United States
- 12 biomedical research has helped to prevent numerous childhood
- 13 killers; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Biomedical researchers are working diligently toward
- 15 cures for diseases such as Alzheimer's disease, arthritis, AIDS,
- 16 cancer, diabetes, epilepsy, heart and lung diseases, mental
- 17 illnesses, multiple sclerosis and countless other diseases that
- 18 affect millions of people throughout the United States; and
