- Robert Alan Lasso, Freemansburg Borough Police Department; and 10
- Deputy Sheriff Kyle David Pagerly, Berks County Sheriff's 11

- 13 WHEREAS, Across the United States the week of May 13 through
- 19, 2012, will be recognized as "National Police Week"; and 14
- 15 WHEREAS, The first National Police Officers' Memorial Day was
- 16 held on May 15, 1982, following a proclamation signed by
- 17 President John F. Kennedy on October 1, 1962, and has continued

- 1 to be observed annually in memory of those police officers who
- 2 made the ultimate sacrifice in the line of duty; therefore be it
- 3 RESOLVED, That the Senate honor the memory of the hundreds of
- 4 police officers who have given their lives in the line of duty
- 5 in this Commonwealth; and be it further
