## A JOINT RESOLUTION

1 2 3	Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, further providing for exemptions and special provisions.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby resolves as follows:
6	Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
7	Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with the provisions of
8	Article XI:
9	That section 2(b)(vi) of Article VIII be amended to read:
10	§ 2. Exemptions and special provisions.
11	* * *
12	(b) The General Assembly may, by law:
13	* * *
14	(vi) Authorize local taxing authorities to exclude from
15	taxation an amount based on the assessed value of homestead
16	property. The exclusions authorized by this clause shall not

1 exceed [one-half of the median assessed value of all] <u>100% of</u>
2 <u>the assessed value of each homestead property within a local</u>
3 taxing jurisdiction. A local taxing authority may not increase
4 the millage rate of its tax on real property to pay for these
5 exclusions.

7 Section 2. (a) Upon the first passage by the General 8 Assembly of this proposed constitutional amendment, the 9 Secretary of the Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article 10 11 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the 12 required advertisements to two newspapers in every county in 13 which such newspapers are published in sufficient time after 14 passage of this proposed constitutional amendment.

15 Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of this (b) 16 proposed constitutional amendment, the Secretary of the 17 Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the 18 advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the 19 Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the required 20 advertisements to two newspapers in every county in which such 21 newspapers are published in sufficient time after passage of 22 this proposed constitutional amendment. The Secretary of the 23 Commonwealth shall submit this proposed constitutional amendment 24 to the qualified electors of this Commonwealth at the first 25 primary, general or municipal election which meets the 26 requirements of and is in conformance with section 1 of Article XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and which occurs at least 27 28 three months after the proposed constitutional amendment is 29 passed by the General Assembly.
