1 2 3	Amending Title 35 (Health and Safety) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for emergency service system billing.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Section 8103 of Title 35 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a definition to read:
8	§ 8103. Definitions.
9	The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
10	shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
11	context clearly indicates otherwise:
12	* * *
13	"Insurer." As follows:
14	(1) An entity that is responsible for providing or
15	paying for all or part of the cost of emergency medical
16	services covered by an insurance policy, contract or plan.

1	The term includes an entity subject to:
2	(i) the act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.682, No.284), known
3	as The Insurance Company Law of 1921;
4	(ii) the act of December 29, 1972 (P.L.1701,
5	No.364), known as the Health Maintenance Organization
6	<u>Act; or</u>
7	(iii) 40 Pa.C.S. Ch. 61 (relating to hospital plan
8	corporations) or 63 (relating to professional health
9	<u>services plan corporations).</u>
10	(2) The term does not include an entity that is
11	responsible for providing or paying under an insurance
12	policy, contract or plan which meets any of the following:
13	(i) Is a homeowner's insurance policy.
14	(ii) Provides any of the following types of
15	insurance:
16	(A) Accident only.
17	(B) Fixed indemnity.
18	(C) Limited benefit.
19	(D) Credit.
20	<u>(E) Dental.</u>
21	(F) Vision.
22	(G) Specified disease.
23	(H) Medicare supplement.
24	(I) Civilian Health and Medical Program of the
25	Uniformed Services (CHAMPUS) supplement.
26	(J) Long-term care.

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1	Section 2. Title 35 is amended by adding a section to read:
2	<u>§ 8158. Billing.</u>
3	(a) General ruleWhen an emergency medical services agency
4	is properly dispatched by a public safety answering point as
5	defined in section 5302 (relating to definitions) and provides
6	medically necessary emergency care, a payment made by an insurer
7	for a claim covered under a health insurance policy for a
8	service performed by the emergency medical services agency
9	during the call shall be paid directly to the emergency medical
10	services agency.
11	(b) ApplicationThis section shall be construed to apply
12	only to emergency medical services agencies that are nonnetwork
13	providers.

14 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
