AN ACT

1 2 3	Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for the registered gross weight limit of certain registration plates.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Sections 1307(a.1), 1338(a), 1341, 1342(a), (c)
7	and (d), 1346, 1348, 1350, 1350.1, 1351, 1352, 1353, 1354(a),
8	1355, 1356, 1357, 1358, 1359(a), 1360, 1362 and 1363 of Title 75
9	of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:
10	§ 1307. Period of registration.
11	* * *
12	(a.1) Seasonal registrationUpon application on a form
13	prescribed by the department, the owner or lessee of a passenger
14	car, recreational motor vehicle, motorcycle, truck or farm
15	vehicle which does not have a gross vehicle weight rating of
16	more than [10,000] <u>14,000</u> pounds may register the vehicle with
17	the department for a period of successive months of less than
18	one year. The applicant shall specify the period of months

during which the vehicle shall be registered. Except when the 1 2 department initially converts a currently valid annual 3 registration to a seasonal registration, the annual fee prescribed for the vehicle by Chapter 19 (relating to fees) 4 shall be paid in full by the applicant regardless of the number 5 6 of months chosen for registration by the applicant. Upon receipt of the appropriate fee and the properly completed form, 7 8 including all information required by this chapter, the department shall issue a seasonal registration that shall expire 9 10 on the last day of the expiration month chosen by the 11 registrant. No insurer of a vehicle belonging to any owner or 12 lessee who obtains a seasonal registration and who applies for 13 or receives a reduced automobile insurance premium on account 14 thereof shall be required to provide any contractual coverage, 15 whether in the form of the provision of a defense or the payment 16 of first-party or third-party benefits or otherwise, to the 17 owner or lessee in connection with any event occurring during 18 that part of the year in which the vehicle is not registered; 19 and such owner or lessee shall be treated for all purposes, 20 including, without limitation, ascertaining rights to stack 21 coverages and to uninsured and underinsured motorist coverage, as a person who does not own that vehicle and has no duty to 22 23 carry financial responsibility on it for that part of the year. * * * 24

25 § 1338. Person with disability plate and placard.

26 (a) Person with disability plate.--On the application of any27 person who:

28 (1) is blind;

29 (2) does not have full use of an arm or both arms;
30 (3) cannot walk 200 feet without stopping to rest;

1 cannot walk without the use of, or assistance from, (4) 2 a brace, cane, crutch, another person, prosthetic device, wheelchair or other assistive device; 3

4 (5) is restricted by lung disease to such an extent that the person's forced (respiratory) expiratory volume for one 5 6 second, when measured by spirometry, is less than one liter 7 or the arterial oxygen tension is less than 60 mm/hg on room 8 air at rest;

(6) uses portable oxygen;

has a cardiac condition to the extent that the 10 (7)11 person's functional limitations are classified in severity as 12 Class III or Class IV according to the standards set by the American Heart Association; 13

14

is severely limited in his or her ability to walk (8) due to an arthritic, neurological or orthopedic condition; or 15

16 (9) is a person in loco parentis of a person specified 17 in paragraph (1), (2), (3), (4), (5), (6), (7) or (8); the department shall issue a special registration plate for one 18 19 passenger car or truck with a registered gross weight of not more than [10,000] <u>14,000</u> pounds, designating the vehicle so 20 21 licensed as being used by a person with a disability. Special 22 plates for persons with disabilities may also be issued for vehicles operated exclusively for the use and benefit of persons 23 24 with disabilities. In the case of a motorcycle, the department 25 shall issue a decal containing the international symbol for 26 access for persons with disabilities for display on the 27 registration plate.

29 § 1341. Special registration plates generally.

Upon request by the applicant, the department may issue 30

registration plates consisting of any combination of numbers, 1 2 letters or numbers and letters. These special plates may be 3 issued for special groups or for special purposes and bear an appropriate designation. Special groups may charge a fee for 4 authorization to request a registration plate bearing the name 5 6 of the group. They shall have the same force and effect as regular registration plates. The department may refuse any 7 8 combination of letters and numbers for cause and shall adopt reasonable rules and regulations for the issuance of the plates 9 10 and for carrying out the provisions of this section. The applicant shall comply with all laws and regulations pertaining 11 to registration including the payment of any additional fees. 12 13 The department is authorized to reissue a combination of numbers 14 or letters for a personal plate if the department records reveal 15 that no activity, such as renewal or transfer of the personal 16 registration plate, has occurred for a period of five or more consecutive years and provided that the personal registration 17 18 plate was never reported as lost or stolen. Whenever the 19 department reissues an inactive personal plate, the department 20 may purge its records of all references to the previous owners 21 of that personal plate. The department shall, however, note upon its records the reissuance of the personal plate and to whom the 22 23 plate was issued. The special registration plate may be used 24 only on a passenger car or truck with a registered gross weight 25 of not more than [10,000] <u>14,000</u> pounds. If the vehicle is 26 licensed to a business that is not a member of the special group, the department shall issue the plate as long as the 27 28 business owner or officer making application is a member of that 29 group.

30 § 1342. Veteran plates and placard.

1 Severely disabled veteran plate. -- On the application of (a) 2 a veteran whose service-connected disability is certified at 3 100% by the service unit of the armed forces in which the veteran served or by the United States Veterans' Administration 4 5 or who has a service-connected disability of the type enumerated in section 1338 (relating to person with disability plate and 6 placard), the department shall issue a special registration 7 8 plate designating the vehicle as belonging to a severely disabled veteran. The registration plate shall have a white 9 10 background, shall have blue numbers or letters as the department may determine, shall have the words "disabled veteran" in at 11 least ten-point bold type inscribed in red at the bottom of the 12 13 plate and shall include the international symbol for access for 14 persons with disabilities. Only one special registration plate 15 shall be issued to a veteran under this section. It may be used 16 only on a passenger car or truck with a registered gross weight of not more than [10,000] <u>14,000</u> pounds. In the case of a 17 18 motorcycle, the department shall issue a decal containing the 19 international symbol for access for persons with disabilities and the words "disabled veteran" for display on the registration 20 21 plate.

23 (c) Disabled veteran plates. -- On the application of any 24 veteran having a disability certified by the service unit of the 25 armed forces in which the veteran served or by the United States 26 Veterans' Administration as service-connected, the department shall issue a special registration plate designating the vehicle 27 28 as belonging to a disabled veteran. The registration plate shall 29 have a white background, shall have numbers or letters as the department may determine and shall have the words "disabled 30

veteran" in at least ten-point bold type inscribed at the bottom of the plate. Only one special registration plate shall be issued to a veteran under this section. It may be used only on a passenger car or truck with a registered gross weight of not more than [10,000] <u>14,000</u> pounds.

6 Prisoner of war plate. -- On the application of an ex-(d) 7 prisoner of war whose imprisonment while in the service of the 8 armed forces of the United States is certified by the appropriate branch of the armed forces, the department shall 9 10 issue a special registration plate designating the vehicle as belonging to an ex-prisoner of war. The registration plate shall 11 contain the letters "POW" and such other numbers or letters as 12 13 the department may determine and shall have the words "prisoner 14 of war" in at least ten-point bold type inscribed at the bottom 15 of the plate. Only one special registration plate shall be 16 issued to an ex-prisoner of war under this subsection. The special registration plate may be used only on a passenger car 17 or truck with a registered gross weight of not more than 18 [10,000] <u>14,000</u> pounds. 19

§ 1346. Special plates for recipients of Purple Heart. 21 Upon application of any person who is a recipient of the 22 23 Purple Heart, the department shall issue to such person a 24 special registration plate designating the vehicle so licensed 25 as belonging to a person who is a recipient of the Purple Heart. 26 A severely disabled veteran, as described in section 1342(a) (relating to veteran plates and placard), who is qualified to 27 28 receive a plate under this section may also elect to receive a 29 placard under section 1342(b). The special registration plate 30 may be used only on a passenger car or truck with a registered

1 gross weight of not more than [10,000] <u>14,000</u> pounds.

2 § 1348. Special plates for Pearl Harbor survivors.

3 Upon application of any person who is a survivor of Pearl Harbor, accompanied by a fee of \$20 which shall be in addition 4 5 to the annual registration fee and by such documentation as the department shall require, the department shall issue to such 6 person a special registration plate designating the vehicle so 7 8 licensed as belonging to a person who is a survivor of Pearl Harbor. The special registration plate may be used only on a 9 10 passenger car or truck with a registered gross weight of not more than [10,000] <u>14,000</u> pounds. 11

12 § 1350. Special plates for veterans of Korean War.

13 Upon application of any person who is a veteran of the Korean 14 War, accompanied by a fee of \$20, which shall be in addition to 15 the annual registration fee, and by such documentation as the 16 department shall require, the department shall issue to the person a special registration plate designating the vehicle so 17 18 licensed as belonging to a person who is a veteran of the Korean 19 War. The special registration plate may be used only on a 20 passenger car or truck with a registered gross weight of not more than [10,000] <u>14,000</u> pounds. 21

22 § 1350.1. Special plates for recipients of Korean Defense23 Service Medal.

Upon application of any person who is a recipient of the Korean Defense Service Medal, accompanied by a fee of \$20 which shall be in addition to the annual registration fee and by such documentation as the department shall require, the department shall issue to the person a special registration plate designating the vehicle so licensed as belonging to a person who is a recipient of the Korean Defense Service Medal. 1 department shall design and produce the special registration 2 plate. The special registration plate may be used only on a 3 passenger car or truck with a registered gross weight of not 4 more than [10,000] <u>14,000</u> pounds.

§ 1351. Special plates for veterans of Persian Gulf War. 5 6 Upon application of any person who is a veteran of the 7 Persian Gulf War, accompanied by a fee of \$20, which shall be in 8 addition to the annual registration fee, and by such documentation as the department shall require, the department 9 shall issue to the person a special registration plate 10 designating the vehicle so licensed as belonging to a person who 11 is a veteran of the Persian Gulf War. The special registration 12 13 plate may be used only on a passenger car or truck with a 14 registered gross weight of not more than [10,000] <u>14,000</u> pounds. 15 § 1352. Wild resource conservation plate.

16 The department, in consultation with the Wild Resource Conservation Board, shall design a special wild resource 17 18 conservation registration plate. Upon application of any person, 19 accompanied by a fee of \$35 which shall be in addition to the 20 annual registration fee, the department shall issue the plate 21 for a passenger car, motor home, trailer or truck with a registered gross weight of not more than [10,000] <u>14,000</u> pounds. 22 23 The Wild Resource Conservation Fund shall receive \$15 of each 24 additional fee for this plate.

S 1353. Preserve our heritage registration plate. The department, in consultation with the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission, shall design a special preserve our heritage registration plate. Upon receipt of an application, accompanied by a fee of \$35 which shall be in addition to the annual registration fee, the department shall

issue the plate for a passenger car, motor home, trailer or
 truck with a registered gross weight of not more than [10,000]
 <u>14,000</u> pounds. The Historical Preservation Fund shall receive
 \$15 of each additional fee for this plate.

5 § 1354. Flagship Niagara commemorative registration plate. 6 Plate.--The department, in consultation with the (a) 7 Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission, shall design a 8 Flagship Niagara commemorative registration plate. Upon application of any person, accompanied by a fee of \$35 which 9 10 shall be in addition to the annual registration fee, the department shall issue the plate for a passenger car, motor 11 home, trailer or truck with a registered gross weight of not 12 13 more than [10,000] <u>14,000</u> pounds.

14 * * *

15 § 1355. Zoological plate.

16 The department, in consultation with the Pennsylvania Zoological Council, shall design a special zoological 17 18 registration plate. Upon application of any person, accompanied 19 by a fee of \$35 which shall be in addition to the annual 20 registration fee, the department shall issue the plate for a 21 passenger car, motor home, trailer or truck with a registered gross weight of not more than [10,000] <u>14,000</u> pounds. The 22 23 Zoological Enhancement Fund shall receive \$15 of the fee paid by 24 the applicant for the plate.

25 § 1356. Special plates for recipients of Expeditionary Forces 26 Medal.

Upon application of any person who is a recipient of the Expeditionary Forces Medal, accompanied by a fee of \$20 which shall be in addition to the annual registration fee and by such documentation as the department shall require, the department

1 shall issue to such person a special registration plate 2 designating the vehicle so registered as belonging to a person 3 who is a recipient of the Expeditionary Forces Medal. The 4 special registration plate may be used only on a passenger car 5 or truck with a registered gross weight of not more than 6 [10,000] <u>14,000</u> pounds.

7 § 1357. Special plates for World War II veterans.

8 Upon application of any person who is a veteran of World War II, accompanied by a fee of \$20 which shall be in addition to 9 10 the annual registration fee and by such documentation as the 11 department shall require, the department shall issue to such 12 person a special registration plate carrying the symbol of a 13 ruptured duck designating the vehicle so registered as belonging 14 to a person who is a veteran of World War II. The special 15 registration plate may be used only on a passenger car or truck 16 with a registered gross weight of not more than [10,000] 14,000 17 pounds.

18 § 1358. DARE plate.

19 The department, in consultation with the Pennsylvania 20 Commission on Crime and Delinquency, shall design a special drug abuse resistance education (DARE) registration plate which 21 utilizes the DARE logo or slogan in the design. Upon application 22 23 of any person, accompanied by a fee of \$35 which shall be in 24 addition to the annual registration fee, the department shall 25 issue the plate for a passenger car, motor home, trailer or 26 truck with a registered gross weight of not more than [10,000] 14,000 pounds. The Drug Abuse Resistance Education Program shall 27 28 receive \$15 of each additional fee for this plate.

29 § 1359. Special plates for steelworkers.

30 (a) General rule.--Upon application of any person who is a 20130HB0195PN0201 - 10 -

steelworker, accompanied by a fee of \$20 which shall be in 1 2 addition to the annual registration fee and by such 3 documentation as the department shall require, the department shall issue to such person a special registration plate 4 5 designating the vehicle so licensed as belonging to a person who 6 is a steelworker. The special registration plate may be used only on a passenger car or a truck with a registered gross 7 8 weight of not more than [10,000] <u>14,000</u> pounds. The plate shall bear the likeness of the official emblem of the American Iron 9 10 and Steel Institute.

12 § 1360. Special plates for veterans of Vietnam Conflict. 13 Upon application of any person who is a veteran of the 14 Vietnam Conflict as that term is defined for the awarding of the 15 Vietnam Service Medal, accompanied by a fee of \$20 in addition 16 to the annual registration fee and by such documentation as the department shall require, the department shall issue to the 17 18 person a special registration plate designating the vehicle so 19 licensed as belonging to a person who is a veteran of the 20 Vietnam Conflict. The special registration plate may be used only on a passenger car or truck with a registered gross weight 21 of not more than [10,000] <u>14,000</u> pounds. 22

23 § 1362. Operation Iraqi Freedom veterans plate.

Upon application of any person who is a veteran of the liberation or occupation of Iraq, accompanied by a fee of \$20 which shall be in addition to the annual registration fee and by documentation as the department shall require, the department shall issue to the person a special registration plate designating the vehicle so licensed as belonging to a person who is a veteran of Operation Iraqi Freedom. The special

1 registration plate may be used only on a passenger car or truck
2 with a registered gross weight of not more than [10,000] <u>14,000</u>
3 pounds.

4 § 1363. Operation Enduring Freedom veterans plate.

5 Upon application of any person who is a veteran of the 6 liberation or occupation of Afghanistan, accompanied by a fee of 7 \$20 which shall be in addition to the annual registration fee 8 and by documentation as the department shall require, the department shall issue to the person a special registration 9 10 plate designating the vehicle so licensed as belonging to a 11 person who is a veteran of Operation Enduring Freedom. The special registration plate may be used only on a passenger car 12 or truck with a registered gross weight of not more than 13 14 [10,000] <u>14,000</u> pounds.

Section 2. Section 1364 of Title 75, amended October 24, 2012 (P.L., No.194), is amended to read:

17 § 1364. Special plates for veterans.

18 (a) Honorably discharged veterans. -- Upon application of any 19 person who is an honorably discharged veteran of the armed 20 forces of the United States or a reserve component of the armed 21 forces as defined in 51 Pa.C.S. § 7301 (relating to definitions), accompanied by a fee of \$20 which shall be in 22 23 addition to the annual registration fee and by such 24 documentation as the department shall require, the department 25 shall issue to the person a special registration plate 26 designating the vehicle as belonging to a person who is a 27 veteran of the armed forces of the United States. The special 28 registration plate may be used only on a passenger car or truck 29 with a registered gross weight of not more than [10,000] 14,000 30 pounds.

1 Honoring our veterans. -- Upon application of any person, (b) 2 accompanied by a fee of \$35, which shall be in addition to the 3 annual registration fee and by such documentation as the department shall require, the department shall issue to the 4 person a special registration plate designating the vehicle as 5 belonging to a person who is honoring veterans of the armed 6 forces of the United States. The special registration plate may 7 8 be used only on a passenger car or truck with a registered gross weight of not more than [10,000] 14,000 pounds. The Veterans' 9 10 Trust Fund shall receive \$15 of the fee paid by the applicant 11 for the plate.

Section 3. Section 1365(a) of Title 75 is amended to read: 13 § 1365. Gold Star Family plate.

14 General rule.--Upon application of a family member of a (a) 15 person who was killed while serving on active duty in the 16 military, accompanied by a fee of \$20 which shall be in addition to the annual registration fee and by such documentation as the 17 18 department shall require, the department shall issue to the 19 family member a special registration plate designating the 20 vehicle so licensed as belonging to a family member of a person who was killed while serving on active duty in the military. The 21 department shall design and produce the special registration 22 23 plate carrying the Service Flag Gold Star rimmed with blue which 24 represents sacrifice to the cause of liberty and freedom. The 25 words "Gold Star Family" shall be clearly displayed along the bottom of the plate. The special registration plate may be used 26 only on a passenger car or truck with a registered gross weight 27 28 of not more than [10,000] <u>14,000</u> pounds.

30 Section 4. Section 1366.1(a) of Title 75, added October 24, 20130HB0195PN0201 - 13 - 1 2012 (P.L.1282, No.158), is amended to read:

2 § 1366.1. Special plates for United States military airborne units.

General rule.--Upon application of any person who is a 4 (a) veteran of or a member of a United States military airborne 5 unit, accompanied by a fee of \$20 which shall be in addition to 6 7 the annual registration fee and by such documentation as the 8 department shall require, the department shall issue to the person a special registration plate designating the vehicle so 9 10 licensed as belonging to a person who is a veteran of or a member of a United States military airborne unit. The special 11 12 registration plate may be used only on a passenger car or truck 13 with a registered gross weight of not more than [10,000] 14,000_ 14 pounds. The department shall design and produce the special registration plate to display a set of jump wings and glider 15 16 wings.
