- 1 Amending Title 66 (Public Utilities) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, in restructuring of electric utility
- industry, further providing for additional alternative energy
- 4 sources.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 2814(c) of Title 66 of the Pennsylvania
- 8 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 9 § 2814. Additional alternative energy sources.
- 10 * * *
- 11 [(c) Increase in Tier I.--The commission shall at least
- 12 quarterly increase the percentage share of Tier I alternative
- 13 energy sources required to be sold by an electric distribution
- 14 company or electric generation supplier under section 3(b)(1) of
- 15 the Alternative Energy Portfolio Standards Act to reflect any
- 16 new biomass energy or low-impact hydropower resources that
- 17 qualify as a Tier I alternative energy source under this
- 18 section. No new resource qualifying as biomass energy or low-
- 19 impact hydropower under this section shall be eligible to

- 1 generate Tier I alternative energy credits until the commission
- 2 has increased the percentage share of Tier I to reflect these
- 3 additional resources.]
- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
