5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Section 102 of Title 61 of the Pennsylvania
8	Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a definition to read:
9	§ 102. Definitions.
10	The following words and phrases when used in this title shall
11	have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
12	context clearly indicates otherwise:

14	"Corrections manager." Any of the following:
15	(1) Corrections superintendent 1, 2 or 3.
16	(2) Deputy superintendent 1, 2 or 3.
17	(3) Corrections officer 3, 4 or 5.
18	(4) Unit manager.

1	(5) Facility maintenance manager 1, 2 or 3.
2	(6) Food service manager 1 or 2.
3	(7) Inmate personal services manager.
4	(8) Classification and treatment manager.
5	(9) Classification program manager.
6	(10) Correctional industries manager 1 or 2.
7	<u>(11) Utilities supervisor.</u>
8	(12) Motor freight coordinator.
9	(13) Another classification added to the corrections
10	manager's pay scale for an individual who supervises or
11	administers security and custodial activities at the
12	institutional or agency level.

14	Section 2. Title 61 is amended by adding a section to read:
15	§ 1101.1. Salary of corrections managers.
16	<u>A corrections manager shall receive not less than the same</u>
17	annual percentage salary and fringe benefit increase as received
18	by the highest ranking corrections officer participating in
19	collective bargaining.
20	Section 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2013, or
21	immediately, whichever is later.
