## AN ACT

1 2 3	Amending Title 23 (Domestic Relations) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in child protective services, further providing for education and training.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Section 6383(b) of Title 23 of the Pennsylvania
7	Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a paragraph to read:
8	§ 6383. Education and training.

10	(b) Duties of Department of State
11	* * *
12	(3) Each licensing board with jurisdiction over
13	professional licensees identified as mandated reporters under
14	this chapter shall:
15	(i) Require all persons applying for a license or
16	certification issued by the licensing board to submit
17	documentation acceptable to the licensing board of the
18	completion of at least three hours of approved child
19	abuse recognition and reporting training. Training shall

1	address, but shall not be limited to, recognition of the
2	signs of child abuse and the reporting requirements for
3	suspected child abuse in this Commonwealth. Training
4	shall be obtained from a provider approved by the
5	Department of Public Welfare.
6	(ii) Require all persons applying for the renewal of
7	a license or certification issued by the licensing board
8	to submit documentation acceptable to the licensing board
9	of the completion of at least three hours of approved
10	continuing education every five years. Continuing
11	education shall address, but shall not be limited to,
12	recognition of the signs of child abuse and the reporting
13	requirements for suspected child abuse in this
14	Commonwealth. Continuing education shall be obtained from
15	a provider approved by the Department of Public Welfare.
16	Section 2. The addition of 23 Pa.C.S. § 6383(b)(3) applies
17	to persons applying for a license or certification, or for the
18	renewal of a license or certification, on or after January 1,
19	2015.
20	Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.

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
