## AN ACT

- Amending the act of December 15, 1982 (P.L.1266, No.287), entitled, as amended, "An act conferring limited residency 2 status on military personnel, their dependents and civilian personnel assigned to an active duty station in 3 Pennsylvania, " further providing for attendance at State-5 related and State-owned institutions of higher learning and 6 7 community colleges. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. Section 1 of the act of December 15, 1982 (P.L.1266, No.287), entitled "An act conferring limited 11 12 residency status on military personnel, their dependents and 13 civilian personnel assigned to an active duty station in 14 Pennsylvania, "amended June 28, 1996 (P.L.420, No.60) and July 9, 2010 (P.L.453, No.57), is amended to read: 15 Section 1. (a) General rule. -- The term "resident" or 16
- 18 Commonwealth resident student, when used to determine the rate

"residency," or any other term or expression used to designate a

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19 of tuition to be charged students attending community colleges,

- 1 State-related and State-owned institutions of higher learning
- 2 shall be construed to mean and include any veterans, their
- 3 spouses and dependent children who do not currently reside in
- 4 Pennsylvania. The term shall also be construed to mean and
- 5 <u>include</u> military personnel [or their dependents], their spouses
- 6 and dependent children who are assigned to an active duty
- 7 station in Pennsylvania and who reside in Pennsylvania and any
- 8 civilian personnel [or their dependents], their spouses and
- 9 <u>dependent children</u> employed at a Department of Defense facility
- 10 who are transferred to Pennsylvania by the Department of Defense
- 11 and who reside in Pennsylvania. [Military]
- 12 <u>(a.1) State-related or State-owned institutions.--Veterans,</u>
- 13 their spouses and dependent children, military personnel [and
- 14 their dependents], their spouses and dependent children and
- 15 civilian personnel [and their dependents], their spouses and
- 16 <u>dependent children</u> who are admitted to [a community college or]
- 17 a State-related or State-owned institution shall be charged
- 18 resident tuition rates provided that the student is a resident
- 19 under this section on the first day of the semester or term of
- 20 the [college or] institution.
- 21 (a.2) Community colleges. -- Veterans, their spouses and
- 22 dependent children, military personnel, their spouses and
- 23 <u>dependent children and civilian personnel</u>, their spouses and
- 24 dependent children who are admitted to a community college shall
- 25 be charged the local sponsor rate provided that the student is a
- 26 resident under this section on the first day of the semester or
- 27 <u>term of the college.</u>
- 28 (a.3) Distance learning tuition. -- A community college,
- 29 State-related or State-owned institution of higher learning
- 30 [may] shall charge resident tuition rates to any active military

- 1 personnel and their dependents who are taking college courses or
- 2 receiving other education services through the Internet or by
- 3 other electronic means.
- 4 (b) Definitions. -- As used in this section, the following
- 5 words and phrases shall have the meanings given them in this
- 6 subsection:
- 7 "Community colleges." Institutions now or hereafter created
- 8 pursuant to Article XIX-A of the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30,
- 9 No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, or the act of
- 10 August 24, 1963 (P.L.1132, No.484), known as the Community
- 11 College Act of 1963.
- 12 "Local sponsor." A school district, municipality or county
- 13 board of school directors, or any combination of school
- 14 districts, municipalities or county boards of school directors,
- 15 that participate or propose to participate in the establishment
- 16 <u>and operation of a community college.</u>
- 17 <u>"Local sponsor rate." The tuition charged to an individual</u>
- 18 who is a resident of a school district or municipality that is a
- 19 member of the local sponsor of the community college.
- 20 "Member of a local sponsor." A school district or
- 21 municipality that, alone or with other districts and
- 22 municipalities, is included in a local sponsor.
- "State-owned institutions." Those institutions which are
- 24 part of the State System of Higher Education pursuant to Article
- 25 XX-A of the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the
- 26 Public School Code of 1949.
- 27 "State-related institutions." The Pennsylvania State
- 28 University, the University of Pittsburgh, Temple University and
- 29 Lincoln University and their branch campuses.
- 30 "Veteran." An individual who served in the United States

- 1 Armed Forces, including a reserve component or National Guard
- 2 <u>and who was discharged or released from service under conditions</u>
- 3 other than dishonorable and is eliqible to receive benefits
- 4 under 38 U.S.C. Ch. 33 (relating to post-9/11 educational
- 5 assistance).
- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
