 Section 2. Section 3 of the act is amended to read:
Section 3. Display of [American flag, Commonwealth flag and military flag] <u>flags</u>.

(a) [General rule.--Notwithstanding] Associations.--

5 (1) Notwithstanding any provision in the association's declaration, covenants, bylaws, rules, regulations or other 6 7 instruments or any construction of any of those instruments 8 by an association's executive board, an association may not 9 prohibit the outdoor display of one American flag, 10 Commonwealth flag [and], military flag or Honor and Remember Flag by a unit owner on that unit owner's property or 11 12 property within the exclusive control of a unit owner or that 13 portion of an exterior wall directly attached to the unit if 14 the American flag is displayed in a manner consistent with 4 U.S.C. §§ 4 (relating to pledge of allegiance to the flag; 15 16 manner of delivery) through 10 (relating to modification of 17 rules and customs by President) and a Commonwealth flag [or], 18 military flaq or Honor and Remember Flaq is displayed in 19 accordance with any rules and regulations adopted by the 20 association.

21 (2) An association may adopt rules and regulations, 22 consistent with 4 U.S.C. §§ 4 through 10, regarding the 23 placement and manner of display of the American flag, and an 24 association may adopt rules and regulations regarding the 25 placement and manner of display of a Commonwealth flag [or], 26 military flag or Honor and Remember Flag. An association may 27 adopt rules and regulations regarding the location, size and 28 use of a flaqpole but cannot prohibit the use of wall 29 brackets to display the American flag, Commonwealth flag 30 [and], military flag or Honor and Remember Flag. The size of

the American flag, Commonwealth flag [and], military flag or <u>Honor and Remember Flag</u> to be flown shall not be larger than five feet by three feet. [In addition, any]

(3) Any rules and regulations adopted by the association 4 5 regarding the display of a military flag or Honor and 6 Remember Flag must permit the flying of such flags, in a 7 respectful way, on President's Day, Iwo Jima Flag Raising 8 Day, Vietnam Veterans Day, V-E Day, Armed Forces Day, 9 Memorial Day, Flag Day, Independence Day, Korean War Veterans 10 Armistice Day, V-J Day, Patriot's Day, POW/MIA Recognition 11 Day, Veterans Day, Pearl Harbor Day and the birthday of each 12 branch of the United States Armed Forces.

13 (b) Cemetery entity.--

14 (1) A cemetery entity may not prohibit the outdoor 15 display of one American flag, Commonwealth flag [and], 16 military flag or Honor and Remember Flag on lots if the 17 American flag is displayed in a manner consistent with 4 18 U.S.C. §§ 4 through 10 and a Commonwealth flag [or], military 19 flag or Honor and Remember Flag is displayed in accordance 20 with any rules and regulations adopted by the cemetery 21 entity.

22 (2) A cemetery entity may adopt rules and regulations, 23 consistent with 4 U.S.C. §§ 4 through 10, regarding the 24 placement and manner of display of the American flag, and a 25 cemetery entity may adopt rules and regulations regarding the 26 placement and manner of display of a Commonwealth flag [or], 27 military flag or Honor and Remember Flag. A cemetery entity 28 may adopt rules and regulations regarding the size and 29 location of flags on lots, but such rules or regulations 30 shall not be used as subterfuge to defeat the purposes of

2 (3) A cemetery entity must permit the flying of military flags or Honor and Remember Flags, in a respectful way, on 3 4 President's Day, Iwo Jima Flag Raising Day, Vietnam Veteran's Day, V-E Day, Armed Forces Day, Memorial Day, Flag Day, 5 6 Independence Day, Korean War Veterans Armistice Day, V-J Day, Patriot's Day, POW/MIA Recognition Day, Veterans Day, Pearl 7 8 Harbor Day and the birthday of each branch of the United 9 States Armed Forces.

10 <u>(4)</u> Nothing in this act shall <u>be construed to</u> preclude a 11 lot owner or his heirs or assigns from limiting or 12 prohibiting the display of an American flag, Commonwealth 13 flag [or], military flag <u>or Honor and Remember Flag</u> on a lot. 14 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
