9	(a) CompositionThe Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission
10	is continued as an independent administrative commission and
11	shall consist of ten competent citizens of this Commonwealth who
12	shall be appointed by the Governor by and with the advice and
13	consent of a majority of the members elected to the Senate [for <
14	terms of <del>[</del> eight <del>] <u>four</u> years and until their successors are &lt;</del>
15	appointed and qualified]. <

17 (c) Terms of office and compensation.--The members shall

hold office for terms of [eight] four years [and] EACH AND MAY 1 <---2 CONTINUE TO HOLD OFFICE FOR A PERIOD OF TIME NOT TO EXCEED SIX 3 MONTHS OR until a successor is appointed and qualified, <---WHICHEVER OCCURS FIRST. [A member appointed to fill a vacancy 4 for a period of four years or less may be eligible for 5 appointment to a full eight-year term.] A member who serves [a 6 <---7 full eight-year term or fills a vacancy for a period of more 8 than four years] THREE CONSECUTIVE TERMS shall not be eligible <--for reappointment to the commission. [until a period of eight 9 <---10 years expires.] The members shall receive no compensation for 11 their services but may be reimbursed for travel expenses. When 12 performing any function on behalf of the commission or acting 13 within the scope of their official duties, members of the 14 commission shall be authorized to operate Commonwealth vehicles 15 and watercraft and shall be treated as employees of the 16 Commonwealth for the purposes of automotive and general 17 liability and the act of June 2, 1915 (P.L.736, No.338), known 18 as the Workers' Compensation Act. \* \* \* 19 20 Section 2. The following shall apply: <---21 (1) Except as provided under paragraph (2), the 22 amendment of 30 Pa.C.S. § 301(a) and (c) shall apply to 23 members of the Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission who are 24 appointed on or after the effective date of this section. 25 (2) Notwithstanding paragraph (1), a member of the <---26 Pennsylvania Fish and Boat Commission who serves a full 27 eight-year term or fills a vacancy for a period of more than-28 four years shall be eligible for reappointment to the-29 commission at any time. Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 30
