14	hereby enacts as follows:
15	Section 1. The act of April 14, 1972 (P.L.233, No.64), known
16	as The Controlled Substance, Drug, Device and Cosmetic Act, is
17	amended by adding sections to read:
18	Section 23.1. Police Officer Dismissal Notwithstanding any
19	other provision of law to the contrary, a police officer who is
20	convicted of an offense under section 13(a)(12), or a
21	substantially similar offense in another state, shall be
22	summarily dismissed from employment.
23	Section 23.2. Firefighter DismissalNotwithstanding any

- 1 other provision of law to the contrary, a firefighter who is
- 2 convicted of an offense under section 13(a)(12), or a
- 3 <u>substantially similar offense in another state</u>, shall be
- 4 <u>summarily dismissed from employment.</u>
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
