## AN ACT

1 2 3 4 5	Amending Title 35 (Health and Safety) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in miscellaneous provisions relating to emergency management services, providing for disclosure of caller location in emergencies and for good faith immunity under certain circumstances.
6	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
7	hereby enacts as follows:
8	Section 1. Title 35 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
9	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
10	§ 7714. Disclosure of caller location in emergencies.
11	(a) Duty of wireless providerUpon request of a law
12	enforcement agency, a wireless provider shall provide call
13	location information concerning the wireless device of the user
14	in order for the requesting law enforcement agency to respond to
15	a call for emergency services or an emergency that involves the
16	risk of death or serious physical harm. The wireless provider
17	shall provide the most accurate call location available, given

1	the technical and other limitations that may impact the accuracy
2	of the call location information in the relevant area.
3	(b) Duty of Pennsylvania Emergency Management AgencyThe
4	agency shall obtain contact information for all wireless
5	providers authorized to do business in this Commonwealth in
6	order to facilitate a request from a law enforcement agency for
7	call location information in accordance with this section.
8	(c) Duty of public safety answering pointWhen requested
9	by a law enforcement agency, the public safety answering point
10	as defined in section 5302 (relating to definitions) shall
11	assist the agency to obtain call location information from
12	wireless providers. Such assistance shall be provided only upon
13	the requesting agency's providing information establishing that
14	the call location information is necessary to assist the agency
15	in responding to an emergency that involves the risk of death or
16	serious bodily injury.
17	(d) Good faith immunityNo cause of action shall lie in
18	any court against any wireless provider, its officers,
19	employees, agents or other specified persons for providing call
20	location information while acting in good faith and in
21	accordance with the provisions of this section. A wireless
22	provider shall not be obligated to make an affirmative
23	determination that the requesting law enforcement agency or
24	public safety answering point as defined in section 5302 has met
25	the threshold requirements of subsection (a).
26	(e) RulesThe agency shall adopt rules relative to the
27	notice and disclosure requirements provided in this section.
28	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
