AN ACT

- Amending Title 34 (Game) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for organization of commission.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Section 301(a) and (c) of Title 34 of the
- 6 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:
- 7 § 301. Organization of commission.
- 8 (a) Composition. -- The independent administrative commission
- 9 known as the Pennsylvania Game Commission shall consist of eight
- 10 competent citizens of this Commonwealth who shall be well
- 11 informed on the subject of wildlife conservation and restoration
- 12 and who shall be appointed by the Governor, by and with the
- 13 advice and consent of [two-thirds] a majority of the elected
- 14 members of the Senate.
- 15 * * *
- 16 (c) Term of office and compensation. -- The members of the
- 17 commission shall hold office for terms of [eight years each and

- 1 may continue to hold office for a period of time not to exceed
- 2 six months or] four years and until a successor is appointed and
- 3 qualified.[, whichever occurs first. A member of the commission
- 4 appointed to fill a vacancy for a period of four years or less
- 5 may be eligible for appointment to a full eight-year term. A
- 6 member of the commission who serves a full eight-year term or
- 7 fills a vacancy for a period of more than four years shall not
- 8 be eligible for reappointment to the commission until a period
- 9 of eight years expires.] Commissioners shall receive no
- 10 compensation for their services, but may be reimbursed for
- 11 travel expenses.

- 13 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
