1	(1) A LEARNER'S PERMIT SHALL BE VALID for a period of
2	one year after date of issue, or until the holder of the
3	permit has failed the examination as authorized in section
4	1508 (relating to examination of applicant for driver's
5	license) three times within the one-year period. <u>A person may</u> <
6	LICENSE) THREE TIMES WITHIN THE ONE-YEAR PERIOD. <
7	(2) A PERSON MAY reapply for a motorcycle learner's
8	permit no more frequently than three times in a ten year <
9	FIVE-YEAR period from when the person first applies. A <
10	MOTORCYCLE LEARNER'S PERMIT IS NOT RENEWABLE.
