1 2 3 4	Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, providing for special farmland preservation registration plates and for the use of a portion of the fee for the plate.
5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Title 75 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
8	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
9	§ 1369.1. Farmland preservation registration plate.
10	(a) PlateThe department, in consultation with the Bureau
11	of Farmland Preservation, shall design a special farmland
12	preservation registration plate. Upon application of any person,
13	accompanied by a fee of \$35 which shall be in addition to the
14	annual registration fee, the department shall issue the plate
15	for a passenger car or other vehicle with a registered gross
16	weight of not more than 9,000 pounds.

- 1 (b) Use of fee.--Of each fee paid under subsection (a), \$15
- 2 <u>shall be deposited into the Agricultural Conservation Easement</u>
- 3 <u>Purchase Fund established under the act of June 30, 1981</u>
- 4 (P.L.128, No.43), known as the Agricultural Area Security Law,
- 5 to preserve farmland in Pennsylvania.
- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
