AN ACT

- Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled 1 "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the 2 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the Executive Department thereof and the administrative departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or 5 6 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or 7 8 authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and 9 duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative 10 officers, and of the several administrative departments, 11 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the 12 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive 13 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of 14 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and 15 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, 16 and commissions; and prescribing the manner in which the 17 18 number and compensation of the deputies and all other assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and 19 commissions shall be determined," further providing for 20 21 campus police powers and duties. 22 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

- 25 (P.L.177, No.175), known as The Administrative Code of 1929,

- 1 Section 2416.1. Campus Police Powers and Duties.--* * *
- 2 (d) As used in this section:
- 3 "Campus Police" means all law enforcement personnel employed
- 4 by a State-aided or State-related college or university.
- 5 community college or private college or university who have
- 6 successfully completed a Campus Police course of training
- 7 approved under 53 Pa.C.S. Ch. 21 Subch. D (relating to municipal
- 8 police education and training).
- 9 "College" or "university" means all State-aided or State-
- 10 related colleges and universities, all community colleges and
- 11 <u>all private colleges and universities</u>.
- "Grounds" means all lands and buildings owned, controlled,
- 13 leased or managed by a college or university.
- 14 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
