## AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An 1 act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," further providing for definitions; 5 and providing for notice of peanut or tree nut allergies. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. Section 1401 of the act of March 10, 1949 10 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a clause to read: 11 12 Section 1401. Definitions .-- As used in this article--13 (13) "School building" means a facility used by the school 14 district for the purpose of teaching elementary or middle school 15 16 students. 17 Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read: 18 Section 1422.4. Notice of Peanut or Tree Nut Allergies. -- (a) A school that enrolls an elementary or middle school student who 19

- 1 has a peanut or tree nut allergy shall post a notice that a
- 2 <u>student within the school building has a peanut or tree nut</u>
- 3 allergy. The notice may not identify the student with the
- 4 <u>allergy. The notice shall be placed in plain view within the</u>
- 5 school building at every point of entry and in the cafeteria.
- 6 (b) The school that enrolls the student under subsection (a)
- 7 <u>shall prohibit the sale of any product containing a peanut or</u>
- 8 tree nut in the cafeteria.
- 9 (c) The school that enrolls the student under subsection (a)
- 10 shall notify the school district or joint school board. Within a
- 11 <u>reasonable time after receiving the notice, the school district</u>
- 12 or joint school board shall designate all of the following:
- 13 (1) a cafeteria table to be peanut or tree nut free; and
- 14 (2) one classroom per grade level to be peanut or tree nut
- 15 free.
- 16 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
