AN ACT

- Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled 2 "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the 3 Executive Department thereof and the administrative 4 5 departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or 6 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or 7 8 authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and 9 duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative 10 officers, and of the several administrative departments, 11 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the 12 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive 13 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of 14 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, 15 16 and commissions; and prescribing the manner in which the 17 number and compensation of the deputies and all other 18 assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and 19 commissions shall be determined," regulating appropriations 20 to the Department of Corrections. 21

- 24 Section 1. The act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known
- 25 as The Administrative Code of 1929, is amended by adding a

- 1 <u>Section 915-B. Private Operations Funds.--Commonwealth funds</u>
- 2 appropriated to the Department of Corrections shall not be used
- 3 to privatize or outsource psychological services of State
- 4 correctional institutions.
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
