AN ACT

1 Designating a portion of State Route 23 in West Hempfield
2 Township, Lancaster County, as the SFC Brent Adams Memorial
3 Road.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. SFC Brent Adams Memorial Road.

7 (a) Findings.--

8 (1) SFC Brent Adams was a native of West Hempfield
9 Township, Lancaster County.

10 (2) SFC Adams graduated from Hempfield High School in
11 1983 and later from Indiana University of Pennsylvania.

12 (3) SFC Adams served in the Pennsylvania Army National
13 Guard for almost 18 years and was killed in action on
14 December 1, 2005, in Ramadi, Iraq.

15 (4) SFC Adams was awarded the Bronze Star and a Purple
16 Heart.

17 (5) Before his deployment to Iraq, SFC Adams was

1 employed by Sprint in Pittsburgh and was president of his
2 church council.

3 (6) SFC Adams was the beloved father of Daniel Adams,
4 beloved son of Barbara and John Benard, beloved grandson of
5 K. Arlene Wimer, beloved brother of Melissa Adams and beloved
6 uncle to Alexandria, Lillian and Michael Nalevanko.

7 (b) Designation.--State Route 23 from the intersection of
8 Ivy Drive to the intersection of Prospect Road in West Hempfield
9 Township, Lancaster County, is hereby designated as the SFC
10 Brent Adams Memorial Road.

11 (c) Signs.--The Department of Transportation shall erect and
12 maintain appropriate signs to display the name of the road to
13 traffic in both directions.

14 Section 2. Effective date.

15 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
