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AN ACT

1 Designating a portion of State Route 2038 in Horsham Township,  
2 Montgomery County, as the 2LT James P. Kelly Memorial  
3 Highway.

4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
5 hereby enacts as follows:

6 Section 1. 2LT James P. Kelly Memorial Highway.

7 (a) Findings.--The General Assembly finds and declares as  
8 follows:

9 (1) Upon graduating from LaSalle College in June 1964,  
10 James P. Kelly was commissioned as a Second Lieutenant in the  
11 Army Field Artillery and served as Field Artillery Unit  
12 Commander, A Battery, 2nd Battalion, 320th Artillery, 101st  
13 Airborne Division, USARV.

14 (2) Second Lieutenant James P. Kelly was killed on  
15 September 27, 1965, by an explosive device while serving his  
16 country in Binh Dinh Province, South Vietnam.

1       (b) Designation.--The section of State Route 2038 in Horsham  
2 Township, Montgomery County, from Maple Avenue to Meetinghouse  
3 Road is hereby designated the 2LT James P. Kelly Memorial  
4 Highway.

5       (c) Signs.---The Department of Transportation shall erect  
6 and maintain appropriate signs displaying the name of the  
7 highway to traffic in both directions on the highway.

8 Section 2. Effective date.

9       This act shall take effect immediately.
