## AN ACT

Amending Title 53 (Municipalities Generally) of the Pennsylvania 1 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for initiative of 2 electors seeking consolidation or merger with new home rule 3 charter. 4 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 7 Section 1. Section 735.1(e)(3) and (g)(1) of Title 53 of the 8 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read: § 735.1. Initiative of electors seeking consolidation or merger 10 with new home rule charter. 11 12 (e) Election of members of commission. --\* \* \* 13 14 Each elector shall be instructed to vote on the 15 question and, regardless of the manner of his vote on the 16 question, to vote for the designated number of members of the 17 commission who shall serve if the question is or has been 18 determined in the affirmative by the majority of the whole of

those voting in all the municipalities impacted by the

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1 consolidation or merger.

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(g) Results of election.--

The result of the votes cast for and against the 4 (1)5 question as to the election of a commission and consolidation 6 and merger proceedings shall be returned by the election 7 officers, and a canvass of the election had, as is provided 8 by law in the case of other public questions put to the 9 electors. The votes cast for members of the commission shall 10 be counted and the result returned by the county board of 11 electors of the county in which the municipality, or the 12 greater portion of its territory, is located, and a canvass 13 of the election had, as is provided by law in the case of 14 election of members of municipal councils or boards. <u>If a</u> 15 majority of the whole in the municipalities proposed to be consolidated or merged vote in the affirmative on the 16 17 question, then the commission shall be formed to study the 18 issue of consolidation or merger and to make recommendations 19 as set forth in the question. The designated number of 20 candidates receiving the greatest number of votes shall be 21 elected and shall constitute the commission. If a majority of 22 [those] the whole in the municipalities voting on the 23 question vote against the election of the commission, none of 24 the candidates shall be elected. If two or more candidates 25 for the last seat shall be equal in number of votes, they 26 shall draw lots to determine which one shall be elected. 27

28 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
