AN ACT

Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled 1 "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the 2 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the 3 Executive Department thereof and the administrative departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof, including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or 5 6 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or 7 authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative 8 9 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative 10 officers, and of the several administrative departments, 11 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the 12 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive 13 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of 14 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and 15 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards, 16 and commissions; and prescribing the manner in which the 17 number and compensation of the deputies and all other 18 assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and 19 commissions shall be determined," further providing for 20 powers and duties of the Department of Drug and Alcohol 21 22 Programs. 23 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 24 hereby enacts as follows: 25 Section 1. Section 2301-A(9) of the act of April 9, 1929 26 (P.L.177, No.175), known as The Administrative Code of 1929,

added June 9, 2010 (P.L.348, No.50), is amended and the section

- 2 Section 2301-A. Powers and duties.
- 3 The Department of Drug and Alcohol Programs shall have the
- 4 power and its duty shall be:

- 6 (9) [The department shall have the power to] <u>To</u>
- 7 promulgate the rules and regulations necessary to carry out
- 8 the provisions of this article.
- 9 (10) To promulgate regulations regarding housing
- 10 programs that offer assistance to people with drug or alcohol
- 11 <u>abuse problems, sometimes referred to as recovery houses. The</u>
- 12 <u>regulations shall include, but not be limited to, a</u>
- definition of "recovery house," rights of inspection,
- 14 <u>assignment of rights of inspection and penalties when</u>
- 15 <u>violations of a departmental regulation occur. In order to</u>
- receive any Federal or State funding, a recovery house must
- 17 comply with regulations promulgated by the Department of Drug
- and Alcohol Programs.
- 19 Section 2. The regulations promulgated initially under
- 20 section 2301-A of the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175),
- 21 known as The Administrative Code of 1929, shall be developed
- 22 with the assistance and recommendations of a task force
- 23 consisting of the chairperson and minority chairperson of the
- 24 Public Health and Welfare Committee of the Senate, the
- 25 chairperson and minority chairperson of the Human Services
- 26 Committee of the House of Representatives, the prime sponsor of
- 27 paragraph (10) of section 2301-A of the act and a representative
- 28 of the Drug and Alcohol Services Providers of Pennsylvania.
- 29 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 30 days.
