## AN ACT

- Providing for school pension liability assistance; and establishing the School Pension Liability Assistance Fund.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 CHAPTER 1
- 6 PRELIMINARY PROVISIONS
- 7 Section 101. Short title.
- 8 This act shall be known and may be cited as the School
- 9 Pension Liability Assistance Act.
- 10 Section 102. Definitions.
- 11 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 12 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 13 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 14 "Department." The Department of Education of the
- 15 Commonwealth.
- 16 "Fund." The School Pension Liability Assistance Fund
- 17 established in section 301.
- 18 "Local taxing effort." A rate determined by the Department

- 1 of Education based on a school district's combined real estate
- 2 property tax rate and income tax rate.
- 3 "School district." A school district of the first class A,
- 4 second class, third class or fourth class.
- 5 CHAPTER 3
- 6 SCHOOL PENSION LIABILITY ASSISTANCE
- 7 Section 301. School Pension Liability Assistance Fund.
- 8 (a) Establishment. -- The School Pension Liability Assistance
- 9 Fund is established as a separate fund in the State Treasury.
- 10 (b) Sources. -- The following are sources of the fund:
- 11 (1) Appropriations.
- 12 (2) Return on money in the fund.
- 13 (c) Use. -- The department shall use the fund to make
- 14 disbursements as provided under section 302.
- 15 Section 302. Distribution of funds.
- Notwithstanding any other law, the department shall
- 17 distribute money in the fund in accordance with the calculation
- 18 under section 303.
- 19 Section 303. Calculation of distribution.
- The department shall calculate the payment to be distributed
- 21 to each school district based on the following:
- 22 (1) The total pension liability for the school district.
- 23 (2) The local taxing effort of the school district.
- 24 Section 304. Restrictions.
- 25 All money in the fund shall be used as authorized under this
- 26 act.
- 27 Section 305. Eligibility.
- 28 A school district with a school pension liability after June
- 29 30, 2013, shall be eliqible to receive a distribution from the
- 30 fund.

- 1 Section 306. Pro rata distribution.
- 2 If insufficient funds are appropriated to make payments to
- 3 school districts under this act, the payments shall be made on a
- 4 pro rata basis.
- 5 CHAPTER 51
- 6 MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS
- 7 Section 5101. Effective date.
- 8 This act shall take effect in 60 days.
