## AN ACT

1 2 3 4 5 6	Amending the act of August 15, 1961 (P.L.987, No.442), entitled "An act relating to public works contracts; providing for prevailing wages; imposing duties upon the Secretary of Labor and Industry; providing remedies, penalties and repealing existing laws," authorizing optional prevailing wage ordinances.
7	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8	hereby enacts as follows:
9	Section 1. The act of August 15, 1961 (P.L.987, No.442),
10	known as the Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act, is amended by
11	adding a section to read:
12	Section 13.1. Local Option(a) Notwithstanding any other
13	provision of this act, a political subdivision or an authority,
14	agency or instrumentality of a political subdivision may elect,
15	by ordinance or resolution, to exclude itself from the coverage
16	<u>of this act.</u>
17	(b) A political subdivision or an authority, agency or
18	instrumentality of a political subdivision that elects to

1	exclude itself from this act under subsection (a) may elect to
2	subject itself to the coverage of this act, provided that such
3	election shall not be less than four years after the initial
4	election under subsection (a). A municipality may take
5	subsequent elections to exclude itself from or subject itself to
6	the coverage of this act at periods of no less than four years
7	from the previous election.
8	Section 2. All acts and parts of acts are repealed insofar
9	as they are inconsistent with this act.

10 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
