AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 35 (Health and Safety) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for Wireless E-911
- 3 Emergency Services Fund.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 5311.4(b) and (h) of Title 35 of the
- 7 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to read:
- 8 § 5311.4. Wireless E-911 Emergency Services Fund.
- 9 * * *
- 10 (b) Wireless E-911 surcharge.--[Each wireless service
- 11 customer shall pay a fee, to be known as a] \underline{A} wireless E-911
- 12 surcharge, in an amount of [\$1] \$2 per month for each device
- 13 that provides wireless service for which [that] a customer is
- 14 billed by a wireless provider for wireless service shall be paid
- 15 one dollar from the wireless service customer and one dollar
- 16 from the wireless provider. The fee shall be collected apart
- 17 from and in addition to a fee levied by the wireless provider in
- 18 whole or in part for the provision of 911 services.

1 (1) Wireless providers shall collect the fee on behalf

of the agency as part of their billing process and shall

3 remit the collected fee plus their portion of the fee to the

4 <u>agency. The provider shall</u> have no obligation to take any

legal action to enforce the collection of the surcharge.

Action may be brought by or on behalf of the agency. Upon

written request of the agency, each wireless provider shall

annually provide a list of the names and addresses of those

9 wireless service customers carrying a balance that have

failed to pay the wireless E-911 surcharge. The wireless

11 provider shall not be liable for the unpaid amounts.

- (2) If a wireless provider receives a partial payment for a monthly bill from a wireless service customer, the wireless provider shall apply the payment against the amount the wireless service customer owes the wireless provider first and shall remit to the State Treasurer the lesser amount, if any, resulting from the application.
- (3) The fees collected under this subsection <u>from the</u>

 <u>wireless service customers</u> shall not be subject to taxes or

 charges levied by the Commonwealth or a political subdivision

 of this Commonwealth, nor shall the fees be considered

 revenue of the wireless provider for any purpose.
- (4) The provisions of this subsection shall not apply to sellers, providers or consumers of prepaid wireless telecommunications service.

- 27 (h) Surcharge sunset. -- The wireless E-911 surcharge fee
- 28 established in subsections (b) and (b.1) shall terminate on June
- 29 30, [2014] 2016, unless extended by an act of the General
- 30 Assembly.
