AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain
- provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- laws relating thereto, "providing for film approval by a
- 6 parent or quardian.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- 10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
- 11 section to read:
- 12 <u>Section 1526. Film approval by a parent or guardian.--Prior</u>
- 13 to displaying, as part of its educational program, a motion
- 14 picture rated "R" or "NC-17" by the Motion Picture Association
- 15 of America, a school district shall:
- 16 (1) Notify and obtain written consent from all parents or
- 17 quardians of all students enrolled in the class in which the
- 18 motion picture is to be displayed.
- 19 (2) If any parent or quardian of any student enrolled in the

- 1 class in which the motion picture is to be displayed objects or
- 2 <u>fails to provide written consent to the display of the motion</u>
- 3 picture, not display the motion picture during the current
- 4 school year.
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
