AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
2 Statutes, further providing for reckless driving.

3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4 hereby enacts as follows:

5 Section 1. Section 3736 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
6 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

7 § 3736. Reckless driving.

8 (a) General rule.--Any person who drives any vehicle in
9 willful or wanton disregard for the safety of persons or
10 property is guilty of reckless driving.

11 (a.1) Excess speeding.--Any person who drives any vehicle at
12 a speed of 100 miles per hour or more or in excess of the
13 maximum speed limit by 45 miles per hour or more is guilty under
14 subsection (a).

15 (b) Penalty.--Any person who violates this section commits a
16 summary offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay
17 a fine of \$200.

18 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
