Fund established pursuant to section 1701-A of the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176), known as The Fiscal Code, exceeds \$750,000,000, as certified by the Secretary of the Budget, the deposits made into the General Fund pursuant to subsection (b) (3) shall cease and thereafter be deposited into the Property Tax Relief Fund established pursuant to section 1409 (relating to Property Tax Relief Fund).]
