## AN ACT

1 2 3 4 5 6	Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain provisions applicable as well to private and parochial schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," providing for data collection reduction.
7	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
8	hereby enacts as follows:
9	Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
10	as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
11	section to read:
12	Section 221.2. Data Collection Reduction(a) The
13	department shall:
14	(1) In consultation with the advisory committee established
15	under subsection (c), identify public school entity reporting
16	obligations that are no longer necessary in the areas of
17	finance, human resources, food services, transportation, child
18	accounting, athletics, health and special education and publish
19	a list of such unnecessary reporting requirements in the

1	<u>Pennsylvania Bulletin within ninety (90) days of the effective</u>
2	date of this section.
3	(2) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, suspend all
4	public school entity reporting obligations identified as no
5	longer necessary pursuant to paragraph (1) within one hundred
6	and eighty (180) days of the effective date of this section.
7	(b) Once a reporting obligation has been eliminated pursuant
8	to this section, the Department of Education shall not resume
9	the collection of any data subject to the eliminated reporting
10	obligation.
11	(c) The advisory committee required under this section shall
12	consist of the following:
13	(1) The following members, to be appointed by the Secretary
14	of Education in consultation with education associations
15	representing school districts, charter school entities and area
16	vocational-technical schools:
17	(i) Three school district business managers.
18	(ii) Three charter school entity business managers.
19	(iii) Three area vocational-technical school business
20	managers.
21	(2) The chairman and minority chairman of the Education
22	<u>Committee of the Senate.</u>
23	(3) The chairman and minority chairman of the Education
24	<u>Committee of the House of Representatives.</u>
25	(4) Two members who shall be selected by the secretary from
26	among the citizens of this Commonwealth.
27	(d) For purposes of this section:
28	(1) "Charter school entity" shall mean a charter school,
29	regional charter school or cyber charter school as such terms
30	are defined in section 1703-A.
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- 1 (2) "Public school entity" shall mean any of the following:
- 2 <u>(i) An area vocational-technical school.</u>
- 3 <u>(ii) A school district.</u>
- 4 (iii) A charter school entity.
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
