## AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An
- act relating to the public school system, including certain
- provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- laws relating thereto," in school health services, providing for parent educational information regarding eating 5
- 6
- disorders. 7
- 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- hereby enacts as follows:
- 10 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- 11 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
- 12 section to read:
- 13 Section 1425. Parent Educational Information Regarding
- Eating Disorders. -- (a) Each school board shall annually provide 14
- parent educational information regarding eating disorders for 15
- 16 pupils in grades five (5) through twelve (12). Such information
- 17 shall be consistent with quidelines established by the
- 18 Department of Education under subsection (b).
- 19 (b) The Department of Education, in conjunction with the

- 1 Department of Health, shall develop and implement guidelines for
- 2 providing parent educational information regarding eating
- 3 <u>disorders. The policies shall be developed with input from</u>
- 4 organizations and entities including local school boards, school
- 5 <u>superintendents</u>, the National Eating Disorders Association, the
- 6 Pennsylvania Association of School Nurses and Practitioners, the
- 7 Pennsylvania Chapter of the American Academy of Pediatrics, the
- 8 Pennsylvania Academy of Family Physicians, the International
- 9 Association of Eating Disorders Professionals Foundation and the
- 10 Academy of Eating Disorders. In doing so, the Department of
- 11 Education and the Department of Health shall identify and
- 12 <u>develop appropriate additions or revisions to this</u>
- 13 <u>Commonwealth's school health regulations related to development</u>
- 14 of parent educational information, including guidance regarding
- 15 the clear delineation of such health information from other
- 16 <u>administrative documentation</u>. The guidelines developed for local
- 17 school boards under this section shall include:
- 18 (1) the optional development of an eating disorder screening
- 19 program;
- 20 (2) specification of training needs and requirements for
- 21 personnel and volunteers;
- 22 (3) appropriate opt-out and exemption procedures; and
- 23 (4) parental notification procedures for positive
- 24 <u>indications of an eating disorder.</u>
- 25 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
