- 1 Amending Title 68 (Real and Personal Property) of the

- further providing for definitions; and, in seller
- 4 disclosures, further providing for application of chapter and <--
- 5 for disclosure form.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Section 7102 of Title 68 of the Pennsylvania
- 9 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a definition to read:
- 10 § 7102. Definitions.
- 11 Subject to additional definitions contained in subsequent
- 12 provisions of this part which are applicable to specific
- 13 provisions of this part, the following words and phrases when
- 14 used in this part shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 15 section unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 16 * * *
- 17 <u>"Storm water facility." A basin, pond, ditch, drain, swale,</u>
- 18 culvert, pipe or other manmade feature of land which was

- 1 constructed to temporarily or permanently convey or store IN <--
- 2 ACCORDANCE WITH FEDERAL, STATE OR LOCAL LAW OR REGULATION TO
- 3 TEMPORARILY OR PERMANENTLY CONVEY OR MANAGE storm water.
- 4 Section 2. Section 7302(a)(2) of Title 68 is amended to <--
- 5 read:
- 6 § 7302. Application of chapter.
- 7 (a) General rule.—This chapter shall apply to all—
- 8 residential real estate transfers except the following:
- 9 * * *
- 10 (2) Transfers of new residential construction that has
- 11 not been previously occupied when:
- 12 (i) the buyer has received a one year or longer
- 13 written warranty covering such construction;
- 14 (ii) the dwelling has been inspected for compliance
- with the applicable building code or, if there is no-
- 16 applicable code, for compliance with a nationally
- 17 recognized model building code; [and]
- 18 (iii) a certificate of occupancy or a certificate of
- 19 code compliance has been issued for the dwelling[.]; and
- 20 <u>(iv) the dwelling is not located on a property</u>
- 21 <u>containing any part of a storm water facility.</u>

- Section $\frac{3}{2}$ 2. Section 7304(b)(13) of Title 68 is amended and <--
- 24 subsection (b) is amended by adding a paragraph to read:
- 25 § 7304. Disclosure form.

- 27 (b) Contents of property disclosure statement. -- The form of
- 28 property disclosure statement promulgated by the State Real
- 29 Estate Commission shall call for disclosures with respect to all
- 30 of the following subjects:

- 2 (13) Soils, drainage [and], boundaries and sinkholes.

- 4 (17) Location and condition CONDITION, IF KNOWN, AND THE <--
- 5 <u>LOCATION of all storm water facilities, including a statement</u>
- 6 <u>disclosing whether ongoing maintenance of the storm water</u>
- 7 <u>facilities is the responsibility of the property owner or the</u>
- 8 <u>responsibility of another person or entity.</u>

- 10 Section 3. For the purpose of implementing the amendment or
- 11 addition of 68 Pa.C.S. § 7304(b)(13) and (17), revisions to the
- 12 property disclosure statement shall be promulgated by the State
- 13 Real Estate Commission within 120 days of the effective date of
- 14 this section as a final-omitted regulation under the act of June
- 15 25, 1982 (P.L.633, No.181), known as the Regulatory Review Act,
- 16 with notice of proposed rulemaking omitted under section 204 of
- 17 the act of July 31, 1968 (P.L.769, No.240), referred to as the
- 18 Commonwealth Documents Law.
- 19 Section 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
