7	Section 1. Section 102 of Title 61 of the Pennsylvania
8	Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a definition to read:
9	§ 102. Definitions.
10	The following words and phrases when used in this title shall
11	have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
12	context clearly indicates otherwise:
13	"Anatomical gift." A donation of all or part of a human body
14	to take effect after the donor's death for the purpose of
15	transplantation, therapy, research or education.

17	Section 2. Title 61 is amended by adding a section to read:
18	<u>§ 5907. Organ donation by inmates.</u>

1	(a) Information to be providedUpon intake, the department
2	shall make available to each inmate a document of gift form
3	which will allow the inmate to indicate the inmate's desire to
4	make an anatomical gift if the inmate dies while in the custody
5	of the department.
6	(b) RecordkeepingIf an inmate indicates a desire to make
7	an anatomical gift, the department shall maintain a record of
8	the inmate's document of gift form.
9	(c) Release of informationIn the event that an inmate
10	dies while in the custody of the department, the department
11	shall release the inmate's document of gift form.
12	(d) PolicyThe department shall establish policy and may
13	promulgate regulations necessary to carry out the provisions of
14	this section.
15	(e) ConstructionNothing in this section shall be
16	construed to authorize the reduction of an inmate's term of
17	imprisonment on the basis of the inmate indicating a desire to
18	<u>make an anatomical gift.</u>
